- Huguenot . . . I. JEAN “JACQUES” GUYON [b. Nov 28, 1637– d. Dec 1, 1694] Merchant & Immigrant from St. Martin, Il de Re, France to Staten Island, NY; Purchased 178 acres on Staten Island Mar 27, 1675.

 Dau of Philippe & Marie Taine Casier from St. Martinique, West Indies; Went back to Europe in 1659 to Manheim, Ger; then Holland and finally Immigrants to America Apr 27, 1660, settled on Van Keulen’s Hook.

 Dau of Samuel & Alice Holmes, Gravesend, Long Island [Note Alice Holms married 2) William Osborne, 3) Daniel Lake. In 1695 Daniel Lake and step-son Joseph Holmes (Mary’s bro) owned 200 acres in Fresh Hills, Staten Island.]
    - 1. JOSEPH HOLMES GUYON [b. abt 1711 – d. 1758] Will dated Dec 7, 1757; Never married, died w/o issue. Dutch Colonial at New Dorp (Lake Tysen) built by Joseph in 1740, inc. 112 acres, granaries and cider houses; Home thought to be haunted, cupboard doors fly open, footsteps upstairs, images of people peering out windows.

 <2<sup>nd</sup> husband Samuel Ward - m. Aug 28, 1765> [Note: Peter Poillon’s will states his *“wife is to have charge of all of my Negros.”* (Unusual to give wife that authority!) Executors: Samuel Holmes, John Poillon, Cornelius Garrison.  
 Witnesses: Philip Guyon, Joseph Holmes and John Daniel.]

 Dau of Richard & Catharine Crocheron Connor; Members of the Moravian Church

Sept 26, 1772 Susannah Martineau [b. abt 1743 – d. 1781] Dau of Stephen & Anntje Van DeVenter Martineau; Granddaughter of Francisco Martineau (Martinoe) <James' 2<sup>nd</sup> Wife>; probably died in childbirth. Martineau's incorporated Moravian Church and Poor House Farm in New Dorp. (Commodore Cornelius Vanderbilt filed suit against some Martineau's wherein James Guyon signed a performance bond to assist them in the real estate matter.)

 <Both 3<sup>rd</sup> Marriages; Margaret's 1<sup>st</sup> Husband was Richard Osborne; 2<sup>nd</sup> Husband was Daniel Lake [d. 1780]. She brought a new born son to this union, Daniel Lake.> Dau of Harmanis & Catherine Paulerson Garritson
- i. DANIEL GUYON [b. abt 1769 – d. July 29, 1826] Son of Ann Conner; Carpenter & Farmer; Lives in "Neck."  
 (Daniel was sponsor at baptism of "Samuel," son of James & Bett, his slaves – Mar 24, 1820 – Moravian Church.)
- m. abt 1789 Frances Garritson [b. – d. Aug 3, 1807] Dau of Hendrick & Hillegont Van Winkle Garritson;  
 Family very active in Moravian Church. Cemetery records say she died with 4 sons and 2 daughters.
- m. Mar 12, 1808 Elizabeth Clawson [d. Sept 27, 1826] <2<sup>nd</sup> Marriage for Both;  
 Elizabeth's first husband was Dr. William Young from Scotland, surgeon in Rev. War – d.1797>
- ANN ELIZABETH GUYON [b. abt 1789 – d. Dec 28, 1833] <2<sup>nd</sup> Wife> Dau of Frances Garritson; Northfield, Richmond Co, NY; On July 4, 1825 had an Independence Day celebration and set their slaves free.

S. Congressman;** Set fire to grounds at Staten Island to quarantine against outbreak of yellow fever 1858.
