- *Note:* Jean Genung, who name originally was Guenon (also rendered Guion) sailed from Amsterdam 2 April 1657 in the ship Draetvat under the command of Captain Beastevaer. He was listed as Jan Guion from Leyden, as as a credit passanger, the price of the voyage being 36 florins. After a 6 week voyage he landed in Flushing, Long Island. He was a farmer and land owner. On 26 September 1680 he petitioned for more land and claimed to have lived there for over 20 years. On 29 September 1683, in Flushing, he possessed: six upland acres, 2 horses, 3 cows, 3 - 2 year olds, 3 swine, and 10 sheep. In a list of inhabitants of Flushing in 1698, John Genung and Margreta were the first named of the French families and this is the first recorded use of the "new" family name.

Note: The town of Perryopolis, PA was laid out in 1814. Many of the original settlers came from New Jersey. The town was named for Oliver Hazard Perry for his victory on Lake Erie in the War of 1812. The land (over 1600 acres) was originally owned by George Washington from about 1769. From 1774-1776 Washington built a grist mill, its progress in being built was waylaid by the Revolutionary War. In 1795 the Providence Meeting House for Quakers was built, and a distillery was built abt 1800. The Gue House, circa 1820, is the oldest surviving house of early settlers.

Note: Frank A. GUE, formerly of *Perryopolis, Fayette, PA, who now lives in Tecumseh, Johnson Co, Neb., claims to have been confined longer in Southern prisons during the Civil War than any other man now living. For 526 days in one period, Gue suffered starvation, privation, exposure and disease, but still lives to tell the tale. He was stricken with smallpox, black scurvy, and chronic diarrhoea (sic) and lay sick for days with scarcely any attention. Six months of his imprisonment was in Andersonville and six weeks of that time in hot weather, an average of 152 dead bodies were carried out every day. Gue served in Co G 86th Reg Indiana Infantry, 1862-65. Carried wounded casualties off the battle field at Chickamauga.

The Petit-Guerard Colony was established in South Carolina about 1680, warrant authorized to Abraham Fluery de la Plaine [b. 1642] of Tours, France for 350 acres. Ninety people sailed on the "Richmond" ship. Among the immigrants was his daughter Marianne who was married to Jacques Du Gue, son of Jacques Du Gue, a merchant from Besance in Berry, France. In 1696 the colony received a grant for an additional 500 acres at St. James, Goose Creek, where his brother Isaac Fluery settled. A Huguenot chapel was built on Abraham's plantation. When he wrote his will in 1721, his plantation consisted of 830 acres, stocked with both Indian and Negro slaves. Records do not indicate that he remarried after coming to America; however, his daughter, Marianne married her second husband, Peter Bacot. She died without other issue than her daughter, Marianne Du Gue, who married Tobias Fitch. Unsure why the colony was named for Rene` Petit and Pierre Guerard. Research by St. Julien R.
